

## NHMRC Equipment Grants in 2004

The NHMRC has allocated \$9 million for Equipment Grants in 2004 to support competitively funded medical research.

The funding has been allocated on a pro rata basis to administering Institutions according to their share of the total funding awarded by the NHMRC for research in 2004. Where an allocation would have been less than \$5, 000 it has been returned into the total pool and redistributed accordingly.

For Equipment Grants for 2004 there is no requirement for the Administering Institutions to provide co funding, as distinct to previous years.

The NHMRC requires administering Institutions to meet the following criteria when making decisions on the equipment to be supported:

- the equipment should support highest quality health and medical research, as supported by the NHMRC (or other competitive grant support);
- consideration to the lack of access to similar equipment in the institution or region; and
- the collaborative gain through use of the equipment eg - multi-user equipment which crosses disciplines, research groups and departments.
