1. About the scheme

1.1 Description

The Postgraduate Scholarship scheme provides funding for successful applicants to attain a research based postgraduate degree (Doctor of Philosophy or Research Masters degree).

1.2 Objectives

The aim of the Postgraduate Scholarship scheme is to support outstanding health, medical and dental graduates early in their career so they can be trained to conduct research that is internationally competitive and develop a capacity for original independent research within Australia.

1.3 Who should apply?

Researchers who wish to attain a research focused postgraduate degree, either:

- > Doctorate of Philosophy (PhD)
- > Research Masters degree (MPhil or equivalent)
