About the Scheme

The NHMRC-European Union Joint Programme scheme aims to provide grants to Australian-based researchers participating as collaborators in multinational consortia under the European Union Joint Programme - Neurodegenerative Disease Research (JPND). NHMRC funding opportunities were available to Australian-based researchers involved in consortia conducting research primarily in neurodegenerative diseases. Applications were assessed through a two-stage peer review process managed by JPND.
