## Boosting Dementia Research Grants Priority Round 4: European Union Joint Program on Neurodegenerative Disease Research (JPND) Call for Multinational Projects on Health and Social Care for Neurodegenerative Diseases

Boosting Dementia Research Grants provides financial support for individual researchers, teams of researchers or organisations to undertake research and implementation projects in the NHMRC National Institute for Dementia Research's (NNIDR) priority areas.

Boosting Dementia Research Grants Priority Round 4 (PR4) provides grants to Australian-based researchers who are participating as collaborators in international consortia under the European Union Joint Program – Neurodegenerative Disease Research (JPND) Call for Multinational Projects on Health and Social Care for Neurodegenerative Diseases. The objective of PR4 is to enable Australian researchers to join ambitious, innovative, multi-national and multi-disciplinary collaborative research projects that address health and social care delivery for people living with dementia and their carers.
