



National Network for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health researchers

for funding commencing in 2021

NHMRC opened the Expression of Interest (EOI) stage of the National Network for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health researchers (National Network TCR) on 4 December 2019. EOI applications closed on 12 February 2020. The full, single application stage was open from 5 August 2020 and closed on 6 November 2020.

The National Network aims to bring together Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health research groups and their support networks to create an inclusive structure that builds the capacity and capability of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health researchers.

The full, single application underwent expert peer review and was found to be of a high quality and relevance to the objectives of the call. Details of the awarded grant are provided below:
