



NHMRC-Network of European Funding for Neuroscience Research (NEURON) applications recommended for funding commencing in 2024

About the Scheme

NEURON was established under the Network of European Funding for Neuroscience Research (ERA-NET) scheme of the European Commission. The ERA-NET NEURON aims to coordinate and optimise research efforts and funding programmes of its partner countries in the field of mental, neurological, and sensory disorders.

The intended outcomes of the NHMRC-NEURON 2023 grant opportunity are to support health and medical research that is of significant benefit to Australia and build upon Australia's mental health research capacity by sharing knowledge and expertise with participating transnational researchers.

The NHMRC-NEURON 2023 grant opportunity will provide support for Australian participation and collaboration in transnational research projects on Mechanisms of Resilience and Vulnerability to Environmental Challenges in Mental Health for a funding period of up to three years.
