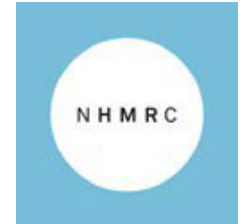

Targeted Call for Research into End of Life Care

For funding commencing in 2021

NHMRC opened a Targeted Call for Research into End of Life Care (EOLC) on 2 September 2020. Applications closed on 28 October 2020.

The purpose of the EOLC TCR is to identify best practice approaches to end of life care that are meaningful for patients, families and carers as well as coordinated and sustainable in the health system.

Applications received during the call were peer reviewed by an expert panel. Following peer review, four applications were funded by NHMRC. Details of the awarded grants are provided below:
